Maintaining certification provides nurses with opportunities to enhance their knowledge following initial certification. Certified nurses periodically reassess their knowledge, and complete learning activities to address any knowledge gaps. Recertification assures patients and peers that certified nurses have maintained current knowledge of cancer care.
